## Officer Reports:

- President Fumex
  - Reviewed the past year

  - Legal review of the ordinances: The ordinances have been sent to an attorney (Bob Leizte). We are awaiting the estimate for the review.
  - Update on projects:
    - Railing and step repair excellent outcome. Suggested we place markers to prevent the snowplow from hitting the stairs.

  - Discussed cleaning drains. The methodology for drain cleaning was discussed. Drains on Toffee needs to be cleaned twice a year.

  - Action Steps:
